Needles Tension

1 pair of 4mm needles 1 pair of 3.25mm needles 22 stitches and 26 rows to 10cm (4in) over stocking stitch on 4mm needles

IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE THE CORRECT SIZING. If you tension square has less stitches, use a thinner needle, if more, use a thicker needle.

BACK

With 4mm needles cast on 104[112:120:128:144]sts.

Row 1: (k1, p1) to end

Last two rows set moss st pattern. Work a further 2 rows in

Row 2: (p1, k1) to end

moss st.

Continue in stst until Back measures 18[20:23:25.5:30]cm (7[8:9:10:12]ins), ending on a ws row.

Next row: k2tog to end (52[56:60:64:72]sts

Next row: purl

Diamond Moss Waistband

Row 1: (p1, k1) to end **Row 2:** (k1, p1) to end.

Row 3: k2[0:2:0:0], *k4, p1, k3; rep from * to last 2[0:2:0:0]sts,

k2[0:2:0:0]

Row 4: p2[0:2:0:0], *p2, k1, p1, k1, p3; rep from * to last

2[0:2:0:0]sts, p2[0:2:0:0]

Row 5: k2[0:2:0:0], *k2, p1, k1, p1, k1, p1, k1; rep from * to last 2[0:2:0:0]sts, k2[0:2:0:0]

Divide for back opening

Next row: k24[26:28:30:34] and leave remaining 28[30:32:34:38]sts on a stitch holder and continue working on these sts.

Row 6: p2[0:2:0:0], (k1, p1) to

last 2[0:2:0:0]sts, p2[0:2:0:0]

Row 7: As Row 5 Row 8: As Row 4 Row 9: as Row 3 Row 10: as Row 2 Row 11: as Row 1

Next row: purl **

Next row: cast on 4 sts, (k1, p1) twice, purl to end (28[30:32:34:38]sts)

Next row: purl to last 4 sts, (p1,

k1) twice

Next row: (k1, p1) twice, purl to

end

Last two rows form patt. Repeat last two rows 3[4:5:6:7] more times, ending on a ws row.

Armhole Shaping

Next and foll alt row: cast off 4 sts, patt to end (20[22:24:26:30]sts)

Next and foll alt row: patt **Next row:** k2tog, patt to end

Next row: patt

Repeat last 2 rows 3 more times

(16[18:20:22:26]sts)

Cont straight in patt until armhole measures 7.5[8:9:9.5:10.5]cm (3[3½:3½:3¾:4½]ins), ending on rs row.

Shape Neck

Next row: cast off 7 sts, purl to end (9[11:13:15:19]sts

Working in stst, dec 1 st at neck edge on each row until you have 6[7:8:9:12]sts remaining. Continue without shaping until armhole measures 10[10.5:11.5:12:12.5]cm (4[4½:4½:4¾:5]ins).

Cast off.

Rejoin yarn to 28[30:32:34:38]sts on st holder and work as follows, working the Buttonhole row in as instructed.

Buttonhole row: in following 5th and following 8th[10th:12th:14th:16th] row work as follows: k1, p2tog, yo, p1, knit to end.

Next row: (k1, p1) twice, knit to end.

Next row: purl to last 4 sts, (p1, k1) twice.

Last two rows form patt. Repeat last two rows 3[4:5:6:7] more times, ending on a rs row.



Armhole Shaping

Next and foll alt row: cast off 4 sts, patt to end. (20[22:24:26:30]sts)

Next and foll alt row: patt **Next row:** p2tog, patt to end

Next row: patt Repeat last 2 rows 3 more times

(16[18:20:22:26]sts)

Cont straight in patt until armhole measures 7.5[8:9:9.5:10.5]cm (3[31/4:31/4:31/4:41/4]ins), ending on ws row.

Shape Neck

Next row: cast off 7 sts, knit to end (9[11:13:15:19]sts

Working in stst, dec 1 st at neck edge on each row until you have 6[7:8:9:12]sts remaining.

Continue without shaping until armhole measures 10[10.5:11.5:12:12.5]cm

10[10.5:11.5:12:12.5] (4[4¼:4½:4¾:5]ins). Cast off.

FRONT

Work as for Back to ** (52[56:60:64:72]sts
Work 6[8:10:12:14] rows in stst.

Shape Armholes

Cast off 4sts at beg of next 4 rows (36[40:44:48:56]

Next row: k2tog, knit to last 2

sts, k2tog
Next row: purl

Repeat last 2 rows 3 more times. (28[32:36:40:48]

Continue straight until Armhole measures 7[7.5:8:9:9.5]cm (2¾[3:3¼:3½:3¾]ins), ending on ws row.

Shape Neck

Next row: knit 12[13:14:15:18] and continue working on these sts, leaving remaining 16[19:22:25:30]sts on a st holder.

Next row: dec 1 st at neck edge of next and every following alt row until 6[7:8:9:12]sts remain.

Continue without shaping until armhole measures 10[10.5:11.5:12:12.5]cm (4[4¼:4½:4¾:5]ins).

Cast off.

Rejoin yarn to 16[19:22:25:30]sts on a st holder.

Next row: cast off 4[6:8:10:12]sts, knit to end. (12[13:14:15:18]sts)

Next row and foll alt rows: purl Next row: dec 1 st at neck edge of next and every following alt row until 6[7:8:9:12]sts remain.

Continue without shaping until armhole measures 10[10.5:11.5:12:12.5]cm (4[4½:4½:4¾:5]ins).

Cast off.

NECKBAND

Sew shoulder seams.

With 3.25mm needles pick up and k5[6:7:8:11] sts across left back, k7 sts up left back neck, k9 sts down left front neck, k4[6:8:10:12]sts along front neck, k9 sts up right front neck, k7 sts down right back neck and k5[6:7:8:11] sts across right back. (46[50:54:58:66]sts)

Next row: knit

Next row: (k1, p1) to end **Next row:** (p1, k1) to end

Next row: k1, p2tog, yo, (p1, k1)

to last st, p1

Next row: (p1, k1) to end Cast off in moss patt.

With 3.25mm needles pick up and knit 42[44:46:48:52]sts evenly around armhole.

Next row: knit

Next row: (k1, p1) to end **Next row:** (p1, k1) to end

Repeat last two rows once more.

Cast off in moss.

Making up

Sew side seams. Sew right back cast on sts to waistband behind left back moss st border. Attach buttons. Sew in loose ends



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
