SHELLS BLANKET

Materials

Baby Pato DK Shade 794 Misty Grey 2 x 100g
 782 Lilac 2 x 100g
 799 White 2 x 100g

5mm Crochet Hook

Darning Needle

Pattern Notes

UK Terminology used

This Blanket is worked in a shell pattern in the round, that creates a square Blanket.

It is a 2 Row repeat, one of Chains and V stitches and the other of Shells.

The blanket is made with 16 rounds of shells but is easily adjusted to any desired size.

CH 3 at the beginning of the round counts as 1 TC.

CH 4 at the beginning of the round counts as 1 TC and 1 CH.

Abbreviations –

TC - Treble Crochet

CH - Chain

SK – Skip

SS - Slip Stitch

REP - Repeat

ST – stitch

BET - Between

REM - Remaining

T - Turn your work

NXT - Next

SP - Space

SHELL – 7 x TC in the same ST

COR SHELL - Corner Shell

V-ST – 1 x TC + CH 1 + 1 TC all into the same ST

COR- Corner - V Stitch + CH3 + V Stitch all in the same Stitch

Pattern

Row 1 – MR / CH 4 (Counts as 1 TC and 1 CH / ** 1 TC / CH 1 ** / REP from ** to ** Until you have a total of 8 TC and a CH BET each ST / CH 1 / SS

Row 2 – SS into the 1st CH SP / CH 3 / 6 TC in the CH SP / In the next CH SP 1 DC / In the next CH SP / 7 TC / In the next CH SP / 1 DC / Repeat in this pattern until the end of the round / SS to the 1st CH

You should have 4 Shells, one on each side

Row 3 – CH 4 / In the DC NXT to the Starting CH work 1 TC (1 V-ST made) / CH 3 / 1 TC + CH 1 + 1 TC all in the same ST / You now have 2 V-STs separated with a CH 3, this is a Corner / CH 5 / In the NXT DC work 1 TC + CH 1 + 1 TC + CH 3 + 1 TC + CH 1 + 1 TC 2nd corner made / CH 5 / In the NXT DC work 1 TC + CH 1 + 1 TC + CH 3 + 1 TC + CH 1 + 1 TC 3rd Corner Made / CH 5 / In the NXT DC work 1 TC + CH 1 + 1 TC + CH 3 + 1 TC + CH 1 + 1 TC 4th Corner Made / CH 5 and SS into the CH SP of the 1st V-ST

Row 4 – CH 3 / 6 TC in the 1st CH SP on the V-ST from the previous round / 1 DC in the CH 3 SP / In the NXT V work 7 TC / Anchor your SHELL down by working a DC into the 4th TC from the row Before / In the NXT V work 7 TC / In the NXT CH SP work 1 DC / REP till the End of the Round Ending with a SS to the top of the CH 3

You should now have 4 sets of 2 Shells



Row 5 – CH 4 / In the DC NXT to the Starting CH work 1 TC / (1 V-ST made) / CH 5 / In the NXT DC work a COR / CH 5 / In the NXT DC work a V-ST / CH 5 / In the NXT DC work a COR / CH 5 / In the NXT DC work a V-ST / REP until you have worked all 4 corners and the V-STs in between / CH 5 and finish with a SS in the CH SP of the 1st V-ST

You should have 4 Corners and 1 V-ST on each side, all separated by a CH 5

Row 6 – CH 3 / 6 TC in the 1st CH SP on the V-ST from the previous round / Anchor your SHELL down by working a DC into the 4th TC from the row Before / In the NXT V work 7 TC / In the NXT CH SP work 1 DC / In the NXT V work 7 TC / Anchor your SHELL down by working a DC into the 4th TC from the row Before / In the NXT V work 7 TC / Anchor your SHELL down by working a DC into the 4th TC from the row Before / REP till the End of the Round Ending with a SS to the top of the CH 3

You should now have a total of 12 Shells – 2 in each of the corners and one on each side

Rep Rows 5 and 6 Your work will INC by 4 Shells per round

Row 7 – 4 COR V-STC / 2 V STS Each side

Row 8 – 2 SHELLS on each COR + 2 SHELLS on each Side (16 Total)

Row 9 – 4 COR V-STC / 3 V STS Each side

Row 10 – 2 SHELLS on each COR + 3 SHELLS on each Side (20 Total)

Row 11 – 4 COR V-STC / 4 V STS Each side

Row 12 – 2 SHELLS on each COR + 4 SHELLS on each Side (24 Total)

And so on.

Finish off, Weave in ends.



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
