## Materials

Pure Baby DK 812	Yarn A	1	1	1	1
Silver Grey 100g					
Pure Baby DK Petal	Yarn B	1	1	1	1
Pink 856					

### Hook

Hook size dependent on size of garment. See table above.

### Tension (10cm/4 inch square)

3.5mm hook: 18 htr x 13 rows

4mm hook: 17 htr x 12 rows

4.5mm hook: 16 htr x 11 rows

5mm hook: 15 htr x 10 rows

IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE THE CORRECT SIZING. If you tension square has less stitches, use a smaller hook, if more, use a larger hook.

## Abbreviations

blo	Work through back of loop only	
ch	Chain	
dc	Double crochet (US single)	Insert hook, yo, pull yarn through, yo, pull through both loops on hook
htr	Half treble (US half double)	Yo, insert hook, yo, pull through, pull through 3 loops on hook
tr	Treble (US double)	Yo, insert hook, yo, pull through, yo, pull through 2 loops on hook, yo, pull through remaining 2 loops
slst	Slip stitch	Insert hook, yo, pull through all loops on hook

## BOTTOM RIBBING

Using 3.5[4:4.5:5]mm hook, 6ch.

**Row 1:** 1dc in 2nd ch and in each ch to end, turn (5dc).

**Row 2:** 1ch (does not count as st) 1dc blo in each dc, turn.

**Rows 3-82:** As row 2.

Fasten off.

## BODY

Using yarn A and 3.5[4:4.5:5]mm hook, work along long side of ribbing as follows:

**Row 1:** (RS) Evenly distribute 84dc along, turn.

**Row 2:** 2ch (counts as 1htr here and throughout), 1htr in each dc, turn (84 htr).

**Row 3:** As row 2.

**Rows 4-5:** As row 2 using Yarn B.

**Rows 6-7:** As row 2 using Yarn A.

**Rows 8-9:** As row 2 using Yarn B.

**Rows 10-11:** As row 2 using Yarn A.

**Rows 12-13:** As row 2 using Yarn B.

**Rows 14-15:** As row 2 using Yarn A.

**Rows 16-17:** As row 2 using Yarn B.

## LEFT FRONT

**Row 1:** Using Yarn A, 2ch, 1htr in first 18 htr, turn (19htr).

**Row 2:** 2ch, 18htr, turn.

**Rows 3-4:** As row 2 using Yarn B.

**Rows 5-6:** As row 2 using Yarn A.

**Rows 7-8:** As row 2 using Yarn B.

**Rows 9-10:** As row 2 using Yarn A.

Fasten off.

## BACK SECTION

With RS facing, rejoin Yarn B to remaining sts with sl st.

**Row 1:** 2ch, 45htr, turn (46htr).

**Row 2:** 2ch, 45htr, turn.

**Rows 3-4:** As row 2 using Yarn A.

**Rows 5-6:** As row 2 using Yarn B.

**Rows 7-8:** As row 2 using Yarn A.

**Rows 9-10:** As row 2 using Yarn B.

Fasten off.

## RIGHT FRONT

With RS facing, rejoin Yarn B to remaining 19 sts with sl st.

Work as for Left Front.

## FRONT RIBBING (make 2)

Using Yarn A, work as for bottom ribbing for 40 rows.

Fasten off.

With RS facing, sl st ribbing on to front sides.

## SLEEVES (both alike)

Cuffs

Work as for Bottom Ribbing working 21 rows.

**Row 1:** Working along long side of the ribbing evenly distribute 23dc

**Row 2:** 2ch, 1htr in each dc (23htr).

**Row 3:** 2ch, htr to last st, 2htr in last htr (24htr).

**Row 4:** As row 3 (25htr).

**Rows 5-8:** As row 2.

**Rows 9-10:** As row 3 (27htr).

**Rows 11-14:** As row 2.

**Rows 15-16:** As row 3 (29htr).

**Rows 17-20:** As row 2.

**Rows 21-21:** As row 3 (31htr).

Fasten off.

## FLOWER

Using Yarn A, 4ch, sl st to form ring.

**Rnd 1:** 8dc into ring.

**Rnd 2:** (1dc, 1htr, 2tr, 1htr) in each dc, sl st to first dc, fasten off.

## TO FINISH

Join shoulder seams

Sew along sleeve seam.

Sew in sleeves.

Attach flower to cardigan add a little button if desired

Sew in ends.
