

CY1259 Cygnet Aran Blush Lacy cardigan Newborn

You Will need -

1 x 100g Balls of Cygnet Aran in Blush 275

5mm Crochet Hook

Darning Needle

1 x 9mm Coconut Button

Pattern Notes

UK Terminology used

The numbers at the end of each round in Brackets, are the amount of Stitches or pattern repeats you should have at the end of that row.

The chain 1 does not count as a stitch. Always work the 1st Stitch straight back down into the base of the chain 1.

Abbreviations -

DC - Double Crochet

TC - Treble Crochet

CH - Chain

SS - Slip Stitch

REP - Repeat

ST - stitch

STS - Stitches

REM - Remaining

T - Turn your work

NXT - Next

V-ST - V Stitch - 1 TC + CH 1 + 1 TC all in the same Stitch

SHELL - 5 x TC in the same Stitch

With your 5mm hook, CH 54

Row 1 – In the 2^{nd} CH DC / DC across (53)

Row 2 – CH 1 / T / TC / V in the NXT / ** SK 1 / V in the NXT / REP from ** across / TC in last (2 TC + 26 V STS)

Row 3 – CH 1 / T / TC / ** V ST in every CH 1 SP of the V's from the previous row REP from ** across / TC in last

Row 4 - CH 1 / T / TC / SHELL in every CH 1 SP of the V's from the previous row / TC in last (2 TC + 26 SHELLS)

Row 5 - CH 1 / T / TC / ** SHELL in the 3rd TC of the SHELL from the row before / REP from ** across / TC in last

Row 6 - REP row 5

Separating for sleeves -

Continue to work shells as before, working the new Shell into the 3rd TC on the shell from the row before.

Row 7 – CH 1 / T / TC / work 4 SHELLS / CH3 / SK 5 SHELLS / work 8 SHELLS / CH 3 / SK 5 SHELLS / work 4 SHELLS / TC in last

Row 8 – CH 1 / T / TC / SHELL in the NXT 4 SHELLS / SHELL in the 2nd CH / SHELL in the NXT 8 SHELLS / SHELL in the 2nd CH / SHELL in the NXT 4 SHELLS / TC in last

Rows 9 to 16 - CH 1 / T / SHELL in all SHELLS / TC in last

(2 TC + 18 SHELLS)

Edge – Attach yarn to the top edge on the front, CH 1 / DC evenly all the way to the bottom / fasten off Repeat for other side

Sew button onto the left side, using one of the pattern holes as a buttonhole / fasten off Weave in Ends.





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
