# CY1326 Pato Baby DK <br> Cluster Corners Blanket 

## You will need -

4.5 mm crochet hook
$1 \times 100 \mathrm{~g}$ ball each of Pato Baby DK in
A - Candy797
B - White 799
C - Lemon 798
Darning needle

## Pattern Notes -

UK terminology used
Cluster stitch - treble crochet 3 together
This pattern is an easy 1 row repeat that will increase by 4 stitches on every side.

| tc - treble crochet | $s p(s)-$ space(s) |
| :--- | :--- |
| htc - half treble crochet | nxt - next |
| cl - Cluster stitch | $t$ - turn your work |
| bet - between | rem - remaining |
| ch - chain | st(s)- stitch(s |
| slst - slip stitch | rept - repeat |

With A ch 8, slst to join into a ring
Row 1 - Into the ring work a ch $1, \mathrm{cl},{ }^{*}$ ch $4, \mathrm{cl}, \mathrm{ch} 2, \mathrm{cl}{ }^{*}$, rept from * to * 2 more times, ch $4, \mathrm{cl}, \mathrm{ch} 2$, slst into 1 st ch 4 sp , fo A

Row 2 - Attach B into any ch $4 \mathrm{sp}, \mathrm{ch} 1,{ }^{*} \mathrm{cl}+\mathrm{ch} 3+\mathrm{cl}$ all into ch $5 \mathrm{sp}, \mathrm{ch} 2,3$ tc into ch $2 \mathrm{sp}, \mathrm{ch} 2$ *, rept * to * 3 more times, slst to of 1 st cl , fo $B$

Row 3 - Attach C into cor ch $3 \mathrm{sp}, \mathrm{ch} 1^{*} \mathrm{cl}+\mathrm{ch} 2+\mathrm{cl}$ all into ch $3 \mathrm{sp}, \mathrm{ch} 2,2$ tc into ch 2 sp , tc into nxt 3,2 tc into ch 2 sp, ch 2 *, rept from * to * 3 more times, slst to top of 1 st cl
(7 tc each side)

Row 4 - slst into cor ch2 sp, ch 1, * cl + ch3 + cl into ch $2 \mathrm{sp}, \mathrm{ch} 2,2$ tc into ch 2 sp , tc into nxt 7,2 tc into ch 2 sp , ch 2 , * rept from * to * 3 more times, slst to top 1 st cl
(11 tc each side)
Row 5 - slst into cor ch $2 \mathrm{sp}, \mathrm{ch} 1,{ }^{*} \mathrm{cl}+\mathrm{ch} 3+\mathrm{cl}$ into ch $3 \mathrm{sp}, \mathrm{ch} 2,2$ tc into ch 2 sp , tc into nxt 11,2 tc into ch 2 sp , ch 2, rept from * to * 3 more times, slst to 1 st cl, fo $C$
( 15 tc each side)
Continue to work as row 5 , increasing 4 stitches every row and changing colours every 3 rows.

- slst over into or attach your yarn in the ch 3 cor sp and ch 1
- work the cor with a cl $+\mathrm{ch} 3+\mathrm{cl}$ all into the ch 3 sp , then ch 2
- work 2 tc into ch 2 sp, tc into the amount of tc available, 2 tc into ch 2 sp , then ch 2
- rept around ending with a slst into the top of the 1 st cl


## With A -

Row 6-19 tc each side
Row 7-23 tc each side
Row 8-27 tc each side

## With B -

Row 9-31 tc each side
Row $10-35$ tc each side
Row 11 - 39 tc each side

## With C -

Row $12-43$ tc each side
Row $13-47$ tc each side
Row $14-51$ tc each side

## Continue to work -

Rows 15 to 17 in A
Rows 18 to 20 in B
Rows 21 to 23 in C
Rows 24 to 26 in $A$

## Border -

27 - Attach A into cor ch 3 sp , ch 1 , * work a cl + ch $3+\mathrm{cl}$ into ch 3 sp , ch 2 , work 1 tc into every tc across, ch 2 , rept from * around, slst into top of 1 st cl , fo A

28 - with B, rept row 27 , fo B
29 - with C, rept row 27 , fo C
30 - Attach A into cor ch 3 sp , ch 1, * 6 htc into ch 3 sp , htc into top of clus, 2 htc into ch 2 sp , htc into every tc across, rept from * around, slst to the top of the 1st htc, fo A

31 - Attach B into any st, ch 1, dc in every st around, slst to 1 st dc
Fasten off, weave in all ends.


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
