Vintage Bobble Stitch Bonnet
Newborn

You will need

4 mm Crochet hook

1 x 100g ball of Cygnet Pure Baby Dk 100% Anti-Pilling Acrylic featured Lilac 21133 & Petal Pink 2124

2 small bows

Darning needle

Pattern Notes –

UK terminology used

b - Bobble st – [yo, insert, yo, pull up a loop, yo, pull through 2 loops] 5 times, yo, pull through all loops, the dc into the next stitch will anchor the bobble down.

Abbreviations	dc – double crochet	b- bobble stitch
mr – magic ring	shell – 5 treble crochet	t - turn your work
tc – treble crochet	ch - chain	nxt - next
htc – half treble crochet	slst - slip stitch	sp(s) – space(s)
htcflo – half treble crochet front loop only	rept - repeat	fo – fasten
htcblo – half treble crochet back loop only	st(s)– stitch(s)	
	rem - remaining	

Bonnet Crown

Make a mr -

- Row 1 - ch1, into ring work 10 tc, slst to 1st tc (10)
- Row 2 - ch 1, 2 tc into every st, slst to 1st tc (20)
- Row 3 - ch 1, 2 tc into 1st st, tc into nxt 1, rept around, slst to 1st tc (30)
- Row 4 - ch 1, 2 tc into 1st st, tc into nxt 2, rept around, slst to 1st tc (40)
- Row 5 - ch 1, 2 tc into 1st st, tc into nxt 3, rept around, slst to 1st tc (50)
- Row 6 - ch 1, [2 tc into 1st, tc into nxt 3] 10 times, slst to 1st tc

Bonnet body

- Row 7 - ch 1, t, htcflo into every st
- Row 8 - ch 1, t, htc across
- Row 9 - ch 1, t, dc into 1st, b into nxt, rept till 2, dc in last 2 sts (24 bobble sts)
- Row 10 - ch 1, t, work a tc into every dc and b st across (50)
- Row 11 - ch 1, t, tc across
- Row 12 - ch 1, t, htc blo across
- Row 13 - rept row 9
- Rows 14 to 16 - ch 1, t, dc in every st across

Ties

Still using your 4mm ch 70, fo and attach at the other side, ch 70, fo

Shell Trim

With the crown facing you, attach your yarn into the ridge that was created on row 7.

Row 17 - Ch1 and work 3 tc into 1st st, *sk 1, dc, sk 1, shell into nxt, rept from * 10 more times, sk2, 3 tc into last st, fo
(11 full + 2 1/2 shells)

Row 18 – working on the ridge created on row 12, repeat row 17

Weave in all ends and attach bows on either side, at the top of the chain tie.



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
