

## CY1343 Pato Baby DK

## $V$ - Stitch Cardigan and Beanie

## Materials:

$1 \times 100 \mathrm{~g}$ ball Pato Baby DK shade Aquamarine 791
4 mm crochet hook
Darning Needle
$5 \times 15 \mathrm{~mm}$ Wooden Buttons

## Pattern Notes:

## UK Terminology used

The numbers at the end of the rounds in brackets, are the amount of stitches/pattern repeats you should have at the end of that row.

The chain 1 does not count as a stitch. Always work into the 1st stitch of the row unless otherwise stated.
V stitch - work treble crochet + chain 1 + treble crochet into the same stitch or space
Gauge - 6 rows and 11 tc Stitches to 8 cm on the yoke

## Size:

Newborn Cardigan

Abbreviations -
ch(s) - chain(s)
tc - treble crochet
htc - half treble crochet dc - double crochet

| inc - Increase, 3 treble crochet | sk - skip |
| :--- | :--- |
| in the same stitch | sp(s) - space(s) |
| $t$ - turn your work | $n x t-n e x t$ |
| $n x t ~-~ n e x t ~$ | vst - v stitch |
| rept - repeat | fo - fasten off |

## Yoke

With your 4 mm hook - chain 54
Row 1- Starting In 2nd ch dc in each st across
Row 2 - ch 1, t, tc 8 , inc, tc 8 , inc, tc 17 , inc, tc 8 , inc , tc 8
Row 3 - ch $1, \mathrm{t}$, tc 9 , inc, tc 10 , inc, tc 19 , inc, tc 10 , inc, tc 9
Row 4 - ch 1, t, tc 10 , inc, tc 12, inc, tc 21 , inc, tc 12, inc, tc 10
Row 5 - ch 1, t, tc 11, inc, tc 14, inc, tc 23, inc, tc 14, inc, tc 11
Row 6 - ch 1, t, tc 12, inc, tc 16, inc, tc 25 , inc, tc 16 , inc, tc 12

## Separating for Sleeves

Row 7 - ch 1 , t, tc 14 , ch 1 , sk 18 , tc 29 , ch 1 , sk 18 , tc 14

## Body

Row 8 - ch $1, \mathrm{t}$, htc across the $14 \mathrm{tc}+1 \mathrm{ch}+29 \mathrm{tc}+1 \mathrm{ch}+14 \mathrm{tc}$

Row 9 - ch 1, t, tc into 1st 2 sts, * vst into nxt, sk 1, rept from * till 2 sts left, tc into last 2
Row 10 - ch $1, \mathrm{t}$, tc into 1 st 2 tc, * vst into ch 1 sp of vst, repeat from * across ending with a tc into last 2 tc
Rows 11 to 17 - repeat row 10

## Sleeves

Row 1 - on sts skipped on row 7, attach yarn under arm and htc the 18 sts +2 more, slst to 1 st htc
Row 2 - ch 1, vst into 1st st, * sk 1, vst into nxt, rept from * around, slst to 1st tc
Row 3 - ch 1, t, * vst into ch 1 sp of vst, rept from * around, slst to 1 st tc
Rows 4 to 8 - rept row 3
Fasten off and repeat for another sleeve

## Buttonhole band

Work on left side for boys or right for girls
Attach at bottom corner
Row 1 - ch 1, dc evenly to the top
Row 2 - ch 1, t, dc into 1st st, * ch 1, sk 1, dc into nxt 5 sts * rept from * to * 4 more times, dc to end
Row 3 - ch 1, t, dc into every dc and ch 1 sp, fo

## Button band

Work on left side for girls or right for boys
Attach at bottom corner
Row 1 - ch 1, dc evenly to the top
Row 2 - ch 1, t, dc into every dc to bottom
Row 3 - ch 1, t, dc into every dc to top, fo
Whip stitch together the gaps under the arms and sew on buttons

## Beanie

Make a magic ring
Row 1 - ch 1,10 tc into ring, slst to 1 st tc
Row 2 - ch 1, 2 tc into every st, slst to 1st tc
Row 3 - ch 1, 2 tc into 1st st, tc into nxt 1, rept around, slst to 1st tc
Row 4 - ch 1, 2 tc into 1st st, tc into nxt 2, rept around, slst to 1st tc
Rows 5 to 7 - ch 1, t, tc around, slst to 1st tc
Row 8 - ch 1 , vst into 1 st st, * sk 1 , vst into nxt, rept from * around, slst to 1 st tc
Row 9 and 10 - ch 1 , t , vst into ch 1 sp of v , rept around, slst to 1 st tc
Fasten off, weave in all ends.

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
