## CYGNET BABY PATO DK DAISY BLANKET

### **Materials**

4.5 mm crochet hook

1 x 100g ball each of Cygnet baby Pato in –

Yarn A – Lemon 798 (background colour 1)

Yarn B – White 799

Yarn C – Soft Grey 793

Yarn D – Mint 790 (background colour 2)

### **Pattern Notes –**

UK terminology used

Finished blanket size – 32” by 43”

The numbers at the end of the rounds in brackets, are the amount of stitches/pattern repeats you should have at the end of that row.

The chain 1 does not count as a stitch. Always work into the 1st stitch unless otherwise stated.

Popcorn stitch – work 5 treble crochet into the same stitch, extend loop upwards about an inch and remove hook.

Insert hook from front to back into 1st treble crochet, place the loop back in your hook and slip stitch through the 1st treble crochet to gather stitches together, chain 1 to close.

## Abbreviations –

ch(s) - chain(s)  
chsp- chain space  
t - turn your work  
nxt – next

rept - repeat  
sk - skip  
sp(s) - space(s)  
slst – slip stitch  
fo – fasten off

cor – corner  
tc – treble crochet  
htc – half treble crochet  
dc – double crochet  
ps – popcorn stitch

**Motifs** – Make 6 of each background colour

With A ch 4, slst to form into a ring

**Row 1** – Into ring, ch 1, 8 dc, slst to 1st dc, fo A (8 sc)

**Row 2** – attach B, ch 1, ps into 1st st, \* ch 1, ps into next, rept from \* around, slst to 1st ps, fo B (8 petals)

**Row 3** – attach C into ch 1 sp that separates the petals, ch 1, \* 3 tc into sp, ch 1, into nxt sp 3 tc + ch 1 + 3 tc, ch 1 \*, rept from \* to \* 3 more times, slst to 1st tc

**Row 4** – slst into nxt ch 1 sp, ch 1, 3 tc into sp, \* ch 1, into ch 1 cor sp 3 tc + ch 2 + 3 tc, ch 1, 3 tc into nxt sp, ch 1, 3 tc into nxt sp \*, rept \* to \* 2 more times, ch 1, into cor sp 3 tc + ch 2 + 3 tc, ch 1, 3 tc into nxt sp, ch 1, slst to 1st tc

**Row 5** - slst into nxt ch 1 sp, ch 1, 3 tc into sp, \* ch 1, into ch 1 cor sp 3 tc + ch 2 + 3 tc, [ch 1, 3 tc into nxt sp] 3 times, \* rept \* to \* 2 more times, ch 1, into cor sp 3 tc + ch 2 + 3 tc, ch 1, [ch 1, 3 tc into nxt sp] 2 times ch 1, slst to 1st tc, fo C

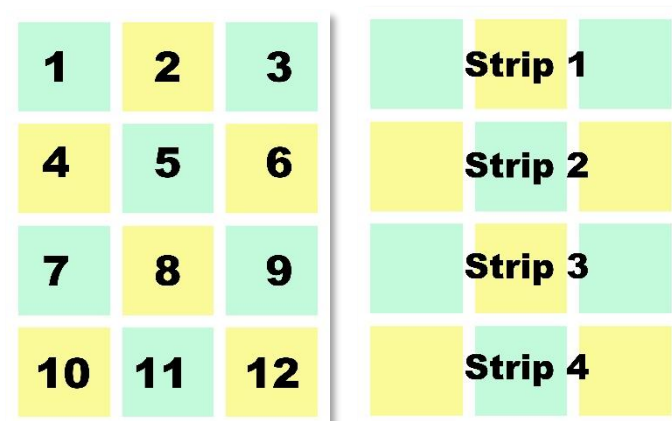
**Rows 6 to 8**– Attach yarn A/D – rept as before, increasing by 1 tc cluster on each side, fo A/D

**Row 9** – ch 1, dc into every tc and ch 1 sp, till you reach the corner, into the cor ch 2 sp work 2 dc + ch 1 + 2 dc, rept all the way around, slst to 1st dc.

Fasten off and weave in ends

## Joining -

Lay out your motifs out as below and join squares as follows –



Line up motifs 1 and 2, with the right sides facing outwards

Attach yarn B into the corner sp and going through both layers, ch 1, dc into every st across making sure the sts are lining up.

Fasten off and repeat, attaching square 3 to 2, your first strip is done.

Lay this strip aside and repeat for the other 3 rows, you should now have 4 strips.

Join the strips in the same way until all 4 and joined following the colour pattern.

## Final rows -

Weave in all ends and attach yarn B into any st across the top.

Chain 1 and htc into every stitch until you reach the corner, into the corner work 2 htc + ch 1 + 2 htc, htc down the side, rept all the way around, placing 1 htc into every st, and 2 htc + ch 1 + 2 htc into every corner, slst to 1st htc, fo B

Attach yarn C, Chain 1 and dc into every stitch until you reach the corner, into the corner work 2 dc + ch 1 + 2 dc, dc down the side, rept all the way around, placing 1 dc into every st, and 2 dc + ch 1 + 2 dc into every corner, fo C

Weave in all ends.



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
