## CyGNET PATO EVERYDAY DK SHELLS BABY SKIRT

## Materials and Measurements

4.5 mm crochet hook

Pato everyday DK Orchid 940
1 ball for small size, 2 balls for medium and large sizes

## Pattern Notes -

UK terminology used
The chain one does not count as a stitch, always work into the 1st stitch unless otherwise stated.

| Abbreviations - | htr - half treble | chsp - chain space | rept - repeat |
| :--- | :--- | :--- | :--- |
| crochet - treble crochet | fphtr - front post | dc - double | slst - slip stitch |
| fptr - front post | half treble crochet | sh(s - shell(s) | sk - skip |
| treble crochet | bphtr - back post | $\mathrm{ch}(\mathrm{s})-$ chain(s) | bet - between |
| bptr - back post <br> treble crochet | half treble crochet | $\mathrm{st}(\mathrm{s})-$ stitches | fo - fasten off |

## Small -

Ch 50, slst to join into a ring
Row 1 - ch 1 , htr into each ch around, slst to $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{htr}$
Row 2 - ch 1, fphtr into $1^{\text {st }}$, * bphtr into nxt, fphtr into nxt, rept from * around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Rows 3 and 4 - ch 1, fphtr into fphtr, bphtr into bphtr, rept around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Row 5 - ch 1, 2 htr into $1^{\text {st }}$ st, * htr into nxt, 2 htr into nxt, rept from * around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Row 6 - ch 1, sh into 1st, * sk 2, sh into nxt, rept from * around, slst to 1st st
Row 7 - slst into ch 1 sp of sh, ch1, * sh into ch1 sp, tr into sp bet shs, rept from * around, slst to 1 st st
Row 8 - slst into ch 1 sp of sh, ch 1 , * sh into ch 1 sp , fptr into tr, rept from * around, slst to 1 st tr
Rows 9 to 19 - slst into ch 1 sp of sh, ch 1 , * sh into ch 1 sp , fptr into fptr, rept from * around, slst to 1st tr

If you want to make the skirt longer, continue to rept row 19 until you reach your desired length.
Final row - slst into ch 2 sp of sh, ch 1 , * into ch 1 sp work $3 \mathrm{tr}+\mathrm{ch} 3$, slst to top of last dc make (picot made) +3 tr, fptr into fptr, rept from * around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st

Fasten off and weave in both ends

## Medium -

Ch 54, slst to join into a ring
Row 1 -ch 1 , htr into each ch around, slst to $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{htr}$
Row 2 - ch 1 , fphtr into $1^{\text {st }}$, * bphtr into nxt, fphtr into nxt, rept from * around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Rows 3 to 5 - ch 1, fphtr into fphtr, bphtr into bphtr, rept around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Row 6 - ch 1, 2 htr into $1^{\text {st }}$ st, * htr into nxt, 2 htr into nxt, rept from * around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Row 7 - ch 1, sh into 1st, * sk 2, sh into nxt, rept from * around, slst to 1st st
Row 8 - slst into ch 1 sp of sh, ch1, * sh into ch1 sp, tr into sp bet shs, rept from * around, slst to 1 st st
Row 9 - slst into ch 1 sp of sh, ch 1 , * sh into ch 1 sp , fptr into tr, rept from * around, slst to 1 st tr
Rows 10 to 22 - slst into ch 1 sp of sh, ch 1 , * sh into ch 1 sp , fptr into fptr, rept from * around, slst to 1st tr

If you want to make the skirt longer, continue to rept row 22 until you reach your desired length.

Final row - slst into ch 2 sp of sh, ch 1 , * into ch 1 sp work $3 \mathrm{tr}+\mathrm{ch} 3$, slst to top of last tr make (picot made) +3 tr, fptr into fptr, rept from * around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st

Fasten off and weave in both ends

## Large -

Ch 58, slst to join into a ring
Row 1 - ch 1 , htr into each ch around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ htr
Row 2 - ch 1, fphtr into $1^{\text {st }}$, * bphtr into nxt, fphtr into nxt, rept from * around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Rows 3 to 6 - ch 1, fphtr into fphtr, bphtr into bphtr, rept around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Row 7 - ch 1, 2 htr into $1^{\text {st }}$ st, * htr into nxt, 2 htr into nxt, rept from * around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st
Row 8 - ch 1, sh into 1st, * sk 2, sh into nxt, rept from * around, slst to 1st st
Row 9 - slst into ch 1 sp of sh, ch1, * sh into ch1 sp, tr into sp bet shs, rept from * around, slst to 1 st st
Row 10 - slst into ch 1 sp of sh, ch 1 , * sh into ch 1 sp, fptr into tr, rept from * around, slst to 1 st tr
Rows 11 to 26 - slst into ch 1 sp of sh, ch 1 , * sh into ch 1 sp, fptr into fptr, rept from * around, slst to 1st tr

If you want to make the skirt longer, continue to rept row 26 until you reach your desired length.
Final row - slst into ch 2 sp of sh, ch 1, * into ch 1 sp work $3 \mathrm{tr}+\mathrm{ch} 3$, slst to top of last tr make (picot made) +3 tr, fptr into fptr, rept from * around, slst to $1^{\text {st }}$ st

Fasten off and weave in both ends


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
