



## CY1447 BABY PATO DK NEWBORN TO 1 MONTH DRESS, NAPPY COVER AND BONNET

### **Materials –**

4mm crochet hook

2 100g balls of Baby Pato DK shade Lemon 798

1 x 10mm button

1 x Rose bow

### **Pattern Notes –**

UK terminology used

The chain 1 does not count as a stitch, always work into the 1<sup>st</sup> stitch of the row.

Shell stitch - work 2 treble crochet + chain 1 + 2 treble crochet all into the same stitch or space.

Inc – work 3 treble crochet into the same stitch or space.

Htr2tog – half treble crochet 2 together decrease.

sk – skip

 slst – slip stitch  
 fo – fasten off

**Dress –****Yoke -**

Ch - 61

Row 1- htr into 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and into each ch across (60)

Row 2 - ch 1, t, tr 7, inc, tr 14, inc, tr 14, inc, tr 14, inc, tr 7

Row 3 – ch 1, t, tr 8, inc, tr 16, inc, tr 16, inc, tr 16, inc, tr 8

Row 4 - ch 1, tr 9, inc, tr 18, inc, tr 18, inc, tr 18, inc, tr 9

Row 5 - ch 1, tr 10, inc, tr 20, inc, tr 20, inc, tr 20, inc, tr 10, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> tr

**Separating for Sleeves -**

Row 6 - ch 1, tr 12, ch 1, sk 22, tr 24, ch 1, sk 22, tr 12, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> tr

Row 7 - ch 1, htr 12, htr into ch 1 sp, htr 24, htr into ch 1 sp, htr 12, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> htr (50)

**Body -**

Row 8 - ch 1, \* 2 htr into nxt st, 1 htr into nxt, rept from \* around, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> htr (75)

Row 9 - ch 1, sh into 1<sup>st</sup> st, \* sk 2, sh into nxt, rept from \* around, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> tr (25 shs)

Row 10 - slst into ch 1 sp, ch 1, \* sh into ch 1 sp, tr into sp bet shs, rept from \* around, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> tr

Row 11 – slst into ch 1 sp, sh 1, \* sh into ch 1 sp, fptr into tr, rept from \* around, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> tr

Row 12 – slst into ch 1 sp, sh 1, \* sh into ch 1 sp, fptr into fptr, rept from \* around, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> tr

Rows 13 to 24 – rept row 12

Row 25 – ch 1, \* dc into nxt 2 tr, dc into ch 1 sp, dc into nxt 2 tr, dc into top of fptr, rept from \* around, slst into 1<sup>st</sup> dc, fo

**Sleeve trim –**

Attach yarn to the underarm area ch 1, and dc evenly around the edge, slst to the 1<sup>st</sup> dc

Fo and repeat for other sleeve

**Neckline trim and buttonhole –**

Attach yarn at the top right side of the neck opening, ch 1, dc 1, ch 2, sk 1 st, dc all the way around to the top edge, fo

## **Nappy Cover –**

Ch 28

- Row 1 – htr into 2<sup>nd</sup> ch, htr across (27)
- Row 2 – ch 1, t, htr2tog, htr 23, htr2tog (25)
- Row 3 - ch 1, t, htr2tog, htr 21, htr2tog (23)
- Row 4 - ch 1, t, htr2tog, htr 19, htr2tog (21)
- Row 5 - ch 1, t, htr2tog, htr 17, htr2tog (19)
- Row 6 – ch 1, t, htr2tog, htr 15, htr2tog (17)
- Row 7 - ch 1, t, htr2tog, htr 13, htr2tog (15)
- Rows 8 to 16 – ch 1, t, htr 15
- Row 17 – ch 1, t, 2 x htr, htr 13 , 2 x htr (17)
- Row 18 – ch 1, t, 2 x htr, htr 15, 2 x htr (19)
- Row 19 – ch 1, t, 2 x htr, htr 17, 2 x htr (21)
- Row 20 – ch 1, t, 2 x htr, htr 19 , 2 x htr (23)
- Row 21 – ch 1, t, 2 x htr, htr 21, 2 x htr (25)
- Row 22 – ch 1, t, 2 x htr, htr 23, 2 x htr (27)

## **Joining -**

Row 23 – ch 1, t, htr 27 across the 1<sup>st</sup> section, ch 3, htr 27 across the nxt section, ch 3, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> htr

Turn the right way out.

Row 24 – ch 1, htr across the 27 htr, 3 chs, 27 htr, 3 chs, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> htr (60)

Rows 25 to 28 – ch 1, htr 60, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> htr

Row 29 – ch 1, fpht into 1<sup>st</sup> st, \*bphtr into nxt, fpht into nxt, rept from \* around, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> st

Rows 30 to 32 – ch 1, fpht into fpht, bphtr into bphtr, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> st, fo

## **Leg trim –**

Attach yarn into the ch 3 area where the sections were joined, ch 1, htr around the edge, ending with approx. 33 sts, fo and repeat for the other leg making sure to end with the same amount of sts

## Bonnet –

Make a magic ring, or alternatively ch 4 and slst to form into a ring

Row 1 – ch 1, into ring work 10 tr, slst to 1st tr (10)

Row 2 – ch 1, fptr into 1st tr, tr into sp bet the tr, rept around, slst to 1st fptr (20)

Row 3 – ch 1, fptr into fptr, into nxt tr work tr + ch 1 + r, rept around, slst to 1st fptr (30)

Row 4 – ch 1, fptr into fptr, into ch1 sp work tr + ch 1+ tr + ch 1 + tr, rept around, slst to 1st fptr (40)

Row 5 – ch 1, fptr into fptr, 2 tr into nxt ch 1 sp, ch 1, 2 tr into nxt ch 1 sp, rept around, slst to 1st fptr (50)

Row 6 – ch 1, \* fptr into fptr, into ch 1 sp work sh, rept from \* 7 more times, fptr into fptr (8 shs)

Row 7 – ch 1, t, bptr into fptr, shell into 3rd tr of shell, rept across

Row 8 – ch 1, t, fptr into bptr, shell into 3rd tr of shell, rept across

Row 9 - rept row 7

Row 10 - rept row 8

Row 11 - ch 1, t, dc across the front working 1 st into every tr and ch 1 sp, when you reach the end, turn and dc across the neckline, slst to 1<sup>st</sup> dc

Don't not fasten off, ch 60 for tie, fasten off, attach at the other side and repeat

Fasten off sew on button to the neckline of the dress, attach bow if desired and weave in all ends.



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
