



CY1499 KIDDIES SUPERSOFT ARAN CABLE SWEATERS

Materials

1 ball of Cygnet Kiddies Supersoft Aran for each sweater Sea Ice 477 or Blush 470

5 and 6mm crochet hooks

1 x 15 mm wooden button for square necked version

Pattern Notes -

Size newborn

UK terminology used

The turning chain 1 does not count as a stitch.

Post stitches will only be worked into post stitches from the row before.

Increase – 3 half treble crochet stitches worked into the same stitch or space.

Abbreviations -

tr – treble crochet dc – double crochet

htr – half treble crochet fptr – front post treble crochet

bptr – back post treble crochet

fpdtr - front post double treble

fphtr - front post half treble

crochet

bphtr - back post half treble

crochet

inc - 3 x htr

ch(s) - chain(s)

slst – slip stitch

chsp-chain space

t - turn your work

nxt - next

rept - repeat

sk - skip

sp(s) - space(s)

cor - corner

slst - slip stitch

fo - fasten off

Square neck -

With 6mm Ch 41 -

Row 1 – htr into 2nd, htr 5, inc, htr 6, inc, htr 12, inc, htr 6, inc, htr 6

Row 2 – ch 1, t, htr 7, inc, htr 8, inc, htr 1, bptr 2, htr 1, bptr 4, htr 1, bptr 2, htr 1, inc, htr 8, inc, htr 7

Row 3 – ch 1, t, htr 8, inc, htr 10, inc, htr 2, fptr 2, htr 1, fptr 4, htr 1, fptr 2, htr 2, inc, htr 10, inc, htr 8

Row 4 – ch 1, t, htr 9, inc, htr 12, inc, htr 3, bptr 2, htr 1, bptr 4, htr 1, bptr 2, htr 3, inc, htr 12, inc, htr 9

Row 5 – ch 1, t, htr 10, inc, htr 14, inc, htr 4, fptr 2, htr 1, sk 2 sts, fpdtr into 3rd and 4th, working in front fpdtr into the 1st then the 2nd skipped sts, htr 1, fptr 2, htr 4, inc, htr 14, inc, htr 10

Separating for sleeves -

Row 6 – ch 1, t, htr 12, ch 1, sk 16, htr 6, bptr 2, htr 1, bptr 4, htr 1, bptr 2, htr 6, ch 1, sk 16, htr 12

Row 7 – ch 1, t, htr 12, htr into ch 1, htr 6, fptr 2, htr 1, fptr 4, htr 1, fptr 2, htr 6, htr into ch 1, htr 12, slst to the 1^{st} st to join

Body -

Row 8 – ch 1, t, htr 19, bptr 2, htr 1, bptr 4, htr 1, bptr 2, htr 19, slst to 1^{st} st

Row 9 - ch 1, t, htr 19, fptr 2, htr 1, sk 2 sts, fpdtr into 3rd and 4th, working in front fpdtr into the 1st then the 2nd skipped sts, htr 1, fptr 2, htr 19, slst to 1st st

Row 10 - ch 1, t, htr 19, bptr 2, htr 1, bptr 4, htr 1, bptr 2, htr 19, slst to 1st st

Row 11 – ch 1, t, htr 19, fptr 2, htr 1, fptr 4, htr 1, fptr 2, htr 19, slst to 1st st

Rows 12 to 19 - rept rows 8 to 11

Row 20 - ch 1, dc into each st around, fo

(48)

Sleeves -

Attach yarn under the arm

Row 1 – ch 1, working evenly around the edge, htr 20 sts, slst to 1^{st} st (20)

Rows 2 to 8 – ch 1, t, htr around, slst to 1st st

Row 9 – ch 1, t, dc, around, slst to 1st st

Fasten off and repeat for other sleeve.

Button band -

Attach yarn on top right edge, ch 1, dc 1, ch 2, dc evenly around, fo

Sew on button and weave in all ends.

Round neck -

With 5 mm hook, ch 40 slst to form into a ring

Row 1 – ch 1, htr into each ch around, slst to 1st st

Row 2 - ch 1, fphtr into 1st st, * bphtr into nxt, fphtr into nxt, rept from * around, slst to 1st st

Change to 6mm hook and commence increases (use stitch markers on each increased st)

Row 3 – ch 1, t, htr 6, inc, htr 6, inc, htr 12, inc, htr 6, inc, htr 6, slst to 1st st

Row 4 - ch 1, t, htr 7, inc, htr 8, inc, htr 1, bptr 2, htr 1, bptr 4, htr 1, bptr 2, htr 1, inc, htr 8, inc, htr 7, slst to 1^{st} st

Row 5 – ch 1, t, htr 8, inc, htr 10, inc, htr 2, fptr 2, htr 1, fptr 4, htr 1, fptr 2, htr 2, inc, htr 10, inc, htr 8, slst to 1st st

Row 6 – ch 1, t, htr 9, inc, htr 12, inc, htr 3, bptr 2, htr 1, bptr 4, htr 1, bptr 2, htr 3, inc, htr 12, inc, htr 9, slst to 1st st

Row 7 – ch 1, t, htr 10, inc, htr 14, inc, htr 4, fptr 2, htr 1, sk 2 sts , fpdtr into 3rd and 4th, working in front fpdtr into the 1^{st} then the 2^{nd} skipped sts , htr 1, fptr 2, htr 4, inc, htr 14, inc, htr 10, slst to 1^{st} st

Separating for sleeves -

Row 8 – ch 1, t, htr 12, ch 1, sk 16, htr 6, bptr 2, htr 1, bptr 4, htr 1, bptr 2, htr 6, ch 1, sk 16, htr 12, slst to 1st st

Row 9 – ch 1, t, htr 12, htr into ch 1, htr 6, fptr 2, htr 1, fptr 4, htr 1, fptr 2, htr 6, htr into ch 1, htr 12, slst to 1st st (50)

Body -

Row 10 – ch 1, t, htr 19, bptr 2, htr 1, bptr 4, htr 1, bptr 2, htr 19, slst to 1st st

Row 11 - ch 1, t, htr 19, fptr 2, htr 1, sk 2 sts, fpdtr into 3rd and 4th, working in front fpdtr into the 1st then the 2nd skipped sts, htr 1, fptr 2, htr 19, slst to 1st st

Row 12 - ch 1, t, htr 19, bptr 2, htr 1, bptr 4, htr 1, bptr 2, htr 19, slst to 1st st

Row 13 – ch 1, t, htr 19, fptr 2, htr 1, fptr 4, htr 1, fptr 2, htr 19, slst to 1st st

Rows 14 to 18 - rept rows 10 to 13

Change to 5 mm hook

Row 19 – ch 1, htr into each st around, slst to 1st st (48)

Row 20 - ch 1, fphtr into 1st st, * bphtr into nxt, fphtr into nxt, rept from * around, slst to 1st st

Row 21 – ch 1, fphtr into fphtr, bphtr into bphtr, rept around, slst to 1st st, fo

Sleeves -

With 6mm hook and wrong side facing attach yarn under the arm

Row 1 – ch 1, working evenly around the edge, htr 20 sts, slst to 1st st

(20)

Rows 2 to 8 - ch 1, t, htr around, slst to 1st st

Change to 5mm hook

Row 9 – fphtr into 1st st, * bphtr into nxt, fphtr into nxt, rept from * around, slst to 1st st Fasten off and repeat for other sleeve.
