



## CYGNET UTOPIA DK CHILDS POCKET SHAWL

### You Will need –

4.5 mm crochet hook

2 x 100g balls of Cygnet Utopia DK – yarn A

1 x 100g ball of Pato everyday DK – Yarn B

### Pattern Notes –

UK terminology used

The chain 1 does not count as a stitch, always work into the 1<sup>st</sup> stitch of the row.

Bobble stitch – worked on the wrong side of the work – [ yarn over, insert, yarn over, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through 2 loops ] 5 times, yarn over, pull through all 6 loops

### Abbreviations –

bb – bobble stitch  
dc – double crochet  
tc – treble crochet  
htc – half treble  
crochet

fptc – front post  
treble crochet  
bptc – back post  
treble crochet  
ch(s) - chain(s)  
chsp- chain space

t - turn your work  
nxt – next  
rept - repeat  
sk - skip  
sp(s) - space(s)  
cor – corner

slst – slip stitch  
fo – fasten off

### 1st pocket section -

With yarn A – ch 31

Row 1 – tc into 4<sup>th</sup> ch from hook, tc into each ch across (29)

Row 2 – ch 1, t, dc 2, \* bb into nxt, dc 3, rept from \* till 3 sts left, bb into nxt, dc 2

Row 3 – ch 1, t, tc into each dc and bb st across

Row 4 – ch 1, t, dc 4, \* bb into nxt, dc 3, rept from \* till 4 sts left, dc 4

Row 5 – rept row 3

Rows 6 to 21 – rept rows 2 to 5 - 4 more times

Rows 22 to 117 – ch 1, t, tc across (29)

If extra length is needed, rept row 22

### 2nd pocket section –

Reminder – bobble rows are always worked on the wrong side

Rows 118 - 131 – rept rows 2 to 5 – 5 more times

Fasten off A and attach B into last st just worked

### Trim –

Row 1 – ch 1, t, working down the side, place \* 2 dc into every tc row and 1 dc into every bb st row, rept from \* till the end

Use stitch markers to pin both pockets in place

Row 2 - ch 1, t, \* going through both layers of the pocket, htc into every dc\*, htc into every dc across till you reach the other pocket, rept from \* to \* till the end

Row 3 – ch 1, t, tc into 1st \* fptc into nxt, bptc into nxt, rept from \* till last st, tc into last

Rows 4 to 6 - ch 1, t, tc into 1st \* fptc into fptc, bptc into bptc, rept from \* till last st, tc into last

Fasten off and repeat for other side

Use remaining yarn to add fringe to bottom edge of pocket.



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
